



Synonym

Points to remember

- Try to identify the meaning.
- If the option is not clear, the choices can be narrowed down to almost half.
- Do not try to have an immediate solution in case of similar options.
- Do not try to cram words and their meanings.
- Out of the four options given, try to look for the meaning of all four.
- Know the part of speech the word is used in.
- To perform well in exam, it is necessary to practice the tips regularly.
